OFFICERS REPORTS

President's report

- Melissa Conti has resigned from donations chairperson role for personal reasons.
 Megan Caspary, who has been co-chair, will become the sole chair.
- SPAC: Our reps weren't able to go to the last meeting but provided input about Aeries.

Treasurer's Report

- **Revenue:** Will be about \$29,000 after Charleston Wrap.
- **Golf cart:** [Aimee] Should golf cart be a line item?
 - Joaquina: I would prefer one because we have routine expenses for golf cart each year. \$500 a year should be fine.
 - Motion made and seconded. All in favor to add a line item of \$500 for the golf cart expenses to each year's budget.
- Spin art machine: [Aimee Saul] Should spin art machine be a fall festival expense?
 - o Joaquina: Yes, it was \$100, purchased from Ginger Hulbert.
- PBIS reimbursement: [Aimee] Where does this come from?
 - o Joaquina and Mr. Otteson: Out of principal's fund.
- Canopies: [Aimee] Should canopies be their own line item in budget or part of fall festival budget?
 - Joaquina: Ashley Hagins donated \$375 toward the purchase of the canopies. The balance of the cost would be from HSC funds.
 - Motion made and seconded. All in favor to set aside \$155 from the budget as a separate line item for the purchase of the canopies.

Principal's Report

- **Beat Lab and King Dance Academy:** Fourth and fifth grades have been working it. Short assembly to show what they've been doing is from 1:45-2:30 p.m. tomorrow (11/15). After Thanksgiving, kinder-third will get training. Big show at the end of January.
- **Tech Academy:** Teacher workroom is in the old computer lab near library. The room off office/teacher's lounge will be the STEAM lab. El Roble was featured in story for Tech Academy blog.
- Fourth and fifth teachers are going to the STEAM trainings. Two teachers are going to a second level of training.
- Mrs. Pearson is going to be a Tech Academy ambassador next summer.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

- Paper Drive: 1,497 reams of paper. About 300 more reams last year.
- Bingo Night: Brought in \$1,329. Made about \$1,000, after expenses.
- **Donations:** \$410 in new corporate donations.
- Anti-bullying handprints: 95% of student population got handprint on the mural this year. Letters on mural were also refreshed.
- **Book fair:** This fall's book fair made \$9,000 overall, which meant a little more than \$4,000 in Scholastic Dollars in profit. We have a total of \$12,000 in Scholastic Dollars.
- Chipotle fundraiser: Earned \$243. We got 30% of proceeds from this event.
- **Gizdich pie fundraiser (5th grade):** 140 pies sold. Jenny Swigart volunteers to chair the fund-raiser for next year's fifth-grade class.
- **Bonanza Day parade:** El Roble won third place. \$1,000 prize. The parade organizers gave us \$750 for supplies to build float.
- Fall Festival report: We had the biggest attendance we've had a fall festival. We paid \$1,000 to Fun Services vs. \$2,000 we paid last year. The High Striker game broke in the

event but we got a discount on the cost. Twelve game booths were made and donated by our school community.
